## Field Memo

### *“DHI Testing Helps Farmers Meet Consumer Demand for High-Quality Milk”*

A little history reminder of the year 1621 - - - the First Thanksgiving was celebrated, Galileo invented the telescope and the first Holstein cow came to United States.

Did you also know the first ice cream parlor opened in New York City in 1776, the same year as our country's Independence? (who says new business can't succeed in a bad economy)

No matter what breed of cattle you have or don't, or if you like ice cream or not, you are all reading this for the same reason, you have something to do with milk. The dairy industry has change drastically since the first cows came and the first ice cream parlor was opened. Dairy cows were kept in or near towns and cities - closer to the growing numbers of people. In the big cities in the early to mid-1800, dairy cows were often kept in dark unsanitary sheds, sometimes less than 10 feet from where milk, cream, and butter were sold to customers. The milk inspector would not approve of that!

As the dairy industry progressed through the 20<sup>th</sup> century and more immigrants came to the US, more and more farms popped up in the countryside. With advancing technology in refrigeration and milking machines, and the growing economy, the number of cows in the US reached to almost 22 million. With the fast-growing dairy industry, and the public demand for more products made from milk, a call for a higher-quality product was demanded. It wasn't just “milk is milk; it is all the same”, like it had been since the first cow was created.

In the last 100 years our grandparents, parents and us are witnessing - and are part of - the greatest change the dairy industry has ever seen. With less farms and cow numbers actually dropping in the United States since the 1950s, from 22 million down to 9.2 million, consumer demand for milk around the world has gone up. Farmers met increased demand with better management and technology. Pounds per cow have doubled since the 1970's. Consumers also demands high-quality milk products and their purchases are how we all get paid. And that is why you are reading this - you are part of Dodge County Dairy Testing, and use testing tools to monitor and manage your production volume and quality.

Most of us think of testing as a tool to help improve your herd, but testing also helps monitor animal health so you are part of meeting the public's demand for healthier cows. With somatic cell count testing and the Udder Health Management Report you are able to make better decisions to lower somatic cell counts.

Since approximately 80% of a cow's metabolic and disease events occur in the weeks following calving, knowing when something is slipping is vitally important. The Fresh Cow Package can help you monitor your fresh and dry cows for ketosis, fatty liver, displaced abomasums and more with the Transition Cow Index (TCI) and the Fat and Protein Ratio.

The Herd Report Card, which came out last summer, tracks and graphs 25 variables within those five management areas. Each is a measure you control with management decisions. Use this benchmarking tool to focus on areas that will maximize profits and keep you competitive. With the advancement of determining Johnnes from a milk sample, and now with the Easy mastitis test you can make better management decisions on what your plan is for an individual cow.

What does this all mean? Healthier cows make more milk. More milk means more money in your pocket. More money in your pocket means the public is buying your product and believes that you as a dairyman care about the product you are producing!

## **Dodge and Fond du Lac County Forage Councils to hold Twilight Meeting June 20th**

Producers, industry partners and representatives from the Midwest Forage Association will usher in the first day of summer at the Dodge and Fond du Lac County Forage Councils Twilight Meeting on Wednesday, June 20<sup>th</sup>. The program will begin at 7:00 p.m. at the Clark Family Farm, Mayville.

The Clark Family Farm is located at W3028 Bauer Road, Mayville, just south of LeRoy. The farm includes 1,600 acres owned and rented. Besides alfalfa, corn for grain and silage, soybeans, wheat and other forages are grown. A 900 unit beef-breed feedlot utilizes much of the homegrown feeds.

Dr. Ed Hopkins, Assistant Wisconsin State Climatologist will provide a better understanding of the basics of weather and how it drives the growing season. Farmers and industry representatives will share forage cultural, harvesting, feeding and marketing practices that work for them.

A whole-hog barbeque lunch will be served. Sponsors of the program are: Schraufnagel Imp. Inc., Knowles Produce and Trading Co., Waupun Equipment, Jacobson Farmers Supply, Agri King, Markesan State Bank, Farmers' Implement, LLC, United Cooperative and others.

This program is open to all interested producers and Forage Council Members. ### **UWEX Farmer to Farmer Web Site Links Buyers and Sellers**

The Farmer to Farmer Corn and Forage Web site is probably best thought of as an electronic neighborhood bulletin board which allows local farmers to get in touch with one another according to Mike Ballweg, University of Wisconsin-Extension crops and soils agent.

The website facilitates the local marketing of feed commodities where livestock producers in need of high moisture corn, corn silage, hay, or straw can easily make contact with sellers that have feed commodities for sale. The site developed and supported by UW-Extension, can be found at <http://farmertofarmer.uwex.edu>.

The Farmer to Farmer Corn and Forage List is free of charge for both buyers and sellers. Users can search for, or list for sale, high moisture corn, corn grain, haylage, hay or straw. Buyers can search for farmers in just one Wisconsin county or in any number of counties at once.

“This site has been an excellent way for buyers and sellers to get in-touch locally,” said Ballweg. “Neighbors often within short distances have been able to buy and sell as a result of the website.”

Buyers can locate feed for their animals easily. Sellers can find buyers and save money in grain drying and marketing costs if they choose to sell their corn crop as high moisture corn or silage. All transactions and negotiations are handled directly between buyers and sellers.

## **2009 Wisconsin Farm Technology Second Round Scholarships and Grants Available Applications - Due June 30, 2012**

The Dodge County Wisconsin Farm Technology Days (FTD) executive committee has announced the availability of the second round of scholarship and grant applications. The grant process will award the distribution of remaining funds from the 2009 Dodge County Wisconsin Farm Technology Days Show.

**Scholarships**, valued at \$1500 for students in a 4- year college program or \$1000 for students in technical school or UW Farm and Industry Short Course are available through the 2009 FTD Scholarship fund. “The first round of scholarships provided nearly \$20,000 to Dodge and neighboring county youths that participated in the 2009 FTD show,” explained Matt Hanson, secretary of the FTE committee. “A similar amount of funds are available for this second round.”

Eligibility and selection of the scholarship winners will be based on the following criterion:

- Applicants who are pursuing post high school education.
- Candidate for the scholarships must be a Dodge County or neighboring county resident
- Candidate must be planning to enter their 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year of college at the time of application.
- Candidate rank in the upper 50% of the class preferred with a grade point of 3.0. Attach high school or college transcript with your application.
- Candidate must have participated in the Dodge County Wisconsin Farm Technology Days activities during the period of 2007 through 2009.

**Grants** - “The first round of grants provided nearly \$70,000 to Dodge County organizations for the development of new programs/projects, or to enhance existing programs related to agriculture,” explained Matt Hanson, secretary of the FTE committee. “A similar amount of funds are available for this second round.”

Members of the Dodge County Farm Technology Days executive committee will evaluate and determine the grant awards which will be given out annually for up to three years. Selection will be based on the application’s intent to:

- Create community and consumer awareness of the importance and impact of agriculture
- Develop innovative educational agriculture experiences or projects
- Offer educational leadership skill-building opportunities and support for youth, families, and adults in Dodge County.

“Only non-profit and public organizations are eligible to apply for grants, with preference given to those based in Dodge County,” Hanson added. “The selection criterion focuses on projects that positively impact Dodge County’s agriculture sector and leadership development, collaborative projects and projects that provide additional or matching resources.”

The application will include a narrative proposal (2 pages maximum), typed in Times New Roman 12 point font and one separate page with detailed budget description.

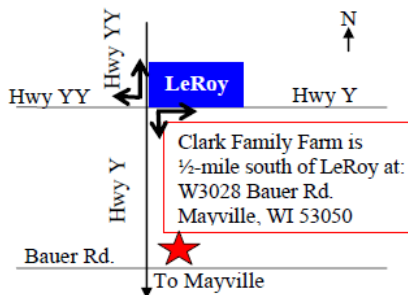
