

Seminar Speakers

Dr. Nigel Cook is a Clinical Associate Professor in the Food Animal Production Medicine section of the University of Wisconsin, School of Veterinary Medicine. He worked as a vet in a large animal clinic in England before moving to the Royal Veterinary College, Hertfordshire, where he spent three years as lecturer and head of the Large Animal Ambulatory Clinic. Since 1999 he has been in Wisconsin, providing a milk quality, lameness and facility troubleshooting service to farmers, teaching veterinary students, and developing research related to the influence of the environment on hoof, udder and fresh cow health.

Dr. Hans Coetzee is an associate professor at Iowa State University. He obtained his Bachelor of Veterinary Science degree from the University of Pretoria, South Africa. He has worked in a mixed animal practice in Northern Ireland and in pharmaceutical research and development at Norbrook Laboratories Ltd. He received a specialist Certificate in Cattle Health and Production from the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons (London) and a doctorate in Veterinary Microbiology from Iowa State University.

Ben Bartlett is a cattle producer and has worked with cattle for 50 years. His past experiences also include working as a Veterinarian, Dairy & Livestock Extension Educator, and private consultant for low stress handling of livestock. Ben states that the "light bulb" moment for him in regards to cattle handling was realizing that can we ASK cattle to do what we want, we don't need to FORCE them. They like it better, it's easier and safer for all, and cattle handling can be enjoyable. Less is more, slower is faster, and it is possible to out- think a cow.

Time for agricultural producers to file tax returns

Agricultural producers need to take a close look at some tax preparation items, says Ron Haugen, North Dakota State University Extension Service farm economist. Following is a partial list from Haugen's full article about items to note for 2011 income tax preparation:

- The 179 expense election is \$500,000. Generally, the 179 expense election allows producers to deduct up to \$500,000 of machinery or equipment purchases for the year of the purchase. There is a dollar-for-dollar phase-out for purchases of more than \$2 million. It is scheduled to revert to \$139,000 for 2012 unless Congress acts.
- The additional first-year bonus depreciation provision is in effect. It is equal to 100 percent of adjusted basis after 179 expensing. It only applies to new property that has a recovery period of 20 years or less. The bonus depreciation is set to return to 50 percent in 2012.
- Long-term capital gains are taxed at a 0 percent rate for individuals in the 10 or 15 percent tax brackets and at 15 percent for those in higher tax brackets.
- The annual IRA contribution is \$5,000 for 2011 or \$6,000 for individuals 50 or older.
- The annual gift tax exclusion is \$13,000.
- The 2011 Social Security wage base is \$106,800.
- The business mileage rate for 2011 is 51 cents per mile to June 30, 2010, and 55 1/2 cents after that.
- Crop insurance proceeds, if received in 2011, may be deferred to 2012 if you qualify. You must use cash accounting and show that, under normal business practices, the sale of damaged crops would occur in a future tax year.
- A livestock deferral can be made by those who had a forced sale of livestock because of a weather-related disaster. Two methods can be used. In the first method, income can be deferred to the next year for all types of livestock sold prematurely. In the second method, income from livestock held for draft, breeding or dairy purposes is not taxed if like-kind animals are repurchased within four years (or more depending on weather conditions or disaster declarations) from the end of the tax year in which the animals were sold. Only the gain on the sale of those animals beyond what normally was sold would qualify for postponement.

Field Memo

“Better Understanding Your Herd Summary”

Explanations for Block H (Peak Milk Trends),
Block I (General Reproductive Information) and
Block M (DIM at 1st Breeding)

Understanding your herd summary is vital to using records for management purpose so we feel that we should highlight different blocks of information in our newsletter with explanations on each. Because of the number of informational boxes this may take several newsletters until we have touched on all of them. We would like to start out by giving an explanation for Block H - Peak Milk Trends ,Block I - General Reproductive Info and Block M - DIM at 1st Breeding.

This block enables the user to track...

- peak milk production trends of first and greater than first lactation cows that freshened between 50 and 360 days ago

Peak milk production for each cow is her highest production in her first 100 DIM. Cows are not represented on the graph until they have reached 50 DIM. If a cow peaks at less than 50 DIM, she will have her early peak recognized at 50 DIM after she is past 100 DIM.

The graph only illustrates the pounds of peak production for each cow, not when in her lactation that she reached peak. The X axis denotes month of calving. The graph allows the user to visually determine if cows recently fresh have higher or lower peaks than those freshening months previously. First lactation cows and cows in their second and greater lactations are differentiated by color. Trend lines illustrate if current peaks are higher or lower or if the herd has seasonal issues. The Peak Ratio = 1st lactation peak milk pounds / 2nd and greater lactation cows peak milk production.

Typical Peak Ratios should be 74-78%. Numbers over 80% indicate underperforming older cows. Below 72% indicates underperforming heifers.

Block I on the **AgSource Herd Summary**. The accuracy and value of all reproductive information is dependent on reporting all breeding dates and pregnancy confirmations. If you elect not to report this your reproductive information within **Block I** will not be accurate.

General Reproductive Info

This block enables the user to track...

- basic reproductive information such as Calving Interval
- conception rates
- dry period lengths
- Voluntary Waiting Period (VWP) information

"Calv Int, Proj" represents the average number of months between the most recent calving date and the expected due date for all pregnant cows in the herd. **Cows must be reported as "Confirmed Pregnant" to AgSource to be included in this calculation and any other calculation on this report involving "Pregnant" animals.**

"Calv Int, Hist" represents the herd's historical calving interval. The "Calv Int, Proj" animals are those still in the herd while the "Calv Int, Hist" animals includes all animals in the herd over the last year.

"Days Open, PG" represents the average days open of all pregnant cows currently in the herd and those that left in the last year. The definition of "pregnant" cows is the same as used above.

"SPC, PG" represents the services per conception of all pregnant cows in the herd and those that left in the last year. The definition of "pregnant" cows is the same as used above.

Field Memo - *continued* . . .

"Conception Rates:" Pregnant animals currently in the herd and those that left in the last year are included in the conception rate subsections. Conception rates ($\#conceptions/\#breedings * 100$) are provided for heifers (prior to first calving), 1st, 2nd and 3rd or greater parity cows.

"Repeat Breeding Analysis"

All cows and heifers in the herd for the current test interval (includes sold/died this test) with breeding events are used. This includes cows/heifers bred, but not pregnant.

See below for the repeat breeding definition:

- Any 2nd or greater breeding in a lactation counts as a repeat breeding.
- Any 2nd or greater breeding that occurs 3 to 17 days after the previous breeding counts as a repeat 3 to 17 day breeding.
- Any 2nd or greater breeding that occurs 18 to 24 days after the previous breeding counts as a repeat 18 to 24 day breeding.

The percent of total 3 to 17 day repeats = count of 3 to 17 day repeats / total number of repeats.

Block M of the **AgSource Herd Summary**. The accuracy and value of all reproductive information is dependent on reporting all breeding dates. If you elect not to report all breedings your reproductive information within **Block M** will not be accurate.

Block M DIM at 1st Breeding

The X axis (along the bottom) denotes the month of calving. Each data point is an individual cow. This scatter graph allows the user to visually observe how tight the time ranges of first breedings are for first and second and greater lactation cows and if there has been any change over the past year. Data points in a tight DIM range indicate a successful synchronization program. The Avg DIM at 1st Breeding ideally should be within 10 days of the Calculated VWP in Block I.

Final Pesticide Applicator Training Dates for 2012

Private applicator training sessions for new and renewal licensing will be held at the Administrative Building in Juneau on Tuesday, March 6th and Wednesday, April 4th. Each session runs from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Registration fees for the program are \$40 and include lunch. Producers choosing to complete the certification program by self study may register and pay \$30 for the instructional materials and complete the test at their convenience.

You qualify as a private applicator if you meet both of the following criteria:

1. You use or direct the use of pesticides for the purpose of producing an agricultural commodity.
2. The applications occur on land owned or rented by you or your employer, or on someone else's land if for exchange of goods or services between agricultural producers.

A private applicator may make incidental applications on someone else's land for monetary compensation if the applications are for the production of an agricultural commodity. Unlike applications made for exchange of goods or services, applications made for money are limited to a total of 500 acres spanning applications for no more than 3 different agricultural producers in any calendar year. If you exceed either limit, you are considered a commercial applicator for hire.

To attend a training session, you must register in advance, in person at the Dodge County UW-Extension Office. Your \$40 fee includes your study materials, your certification, your study materials and lunch on the day of your training.

Understanding the Changes in Bulk Tank Somatic Cell Count Monitoring

US Milk Quality Regulations

Around the world, Somatic Cell Count (SCC) and Standard Plate count (SPC) are the two primary indicators that are used to regulate bulk tank milk quality. Standard plate count measures bacterial quality and is influenced by hygiene and milk cooling. Bacterial quality of most US milk is very high. United States regulations for SPC (<100,000 cfu/ml for Grade A dairy farms and <300,000 cfu/ml for Grade B farms) are consistent or exceed standards of comparable countries. Almost all dairy farms easily achieve the US limit for bacterial count. However, the US SCC limit is not consistent with other dairy producing countries. For example, the European Union, New Zealand and Canada all enforce SCC thresholds of < 400,000 cells/ml. In contrast, the official US limit for SCC is 750,000 cells/ml.

The US Pasteurized Milk Ordinance mandates that milk samples from all farms are officially tested at least 4 times in each 6 month period. Under the current system, if 2 of 4 monthly tests exceed the 750,000 cells/ml the producer is notified by the state regulators and if 3 of 5 tests exceed the limit then milk permit is revoked. While there have been several initiatives to lower the US SCC limit, it is unlikely that the regulatory threshold will be changed in the next few years. Thus, the official regulatory limit that is enforced by the Department of Agriculture Trade and Consumer Protection is not changing. However, many processors will begin enforcing a much stricter SCC limit in order to comply with newly enforced requirements for export of dairy products to the European Union.

Export Requirements for Milk products

The value of exported dairy products has risen from \$1 billion in 2002 to \$3.4 in 2010. While only about 4% of cheese is exported, more than half of all skim milk powder, dry whey and lactose are typically sold on export markets. The ability to maintain these important markets is based on complying with import regulations and harmonization of quality standards has been a contentious issue. After about 2 years of discussion and negotiation, the USDA, Agricultural Marketing Service has finalized requirements for processors who export milk to EU countries. The program is called the "European Health Certification Program" and the transition to complying with the program requirements began on January 1, 2012. After March 31, 2012 all shipments of dairy products to the EU must comply with the new rules. Because the export market is so large, it is likely that most processors will need to comply. So, farmers that supply milk to processors who plan to export to the EU may be affected by these changes.

Rules for Maintaining Compliance with the Export Certification program

1. The European Union SCC and SPC requirement will apply to each farm that supplies milk that may reach the export market. The milk supplier and dairy processors will be responsible for maintaining records that demonstrate that all exported milk products were produced on farms that meet the EU standards for SCC and SPC.
2. Testing of bulk tank milk will be necessary to document compliance. The milk suppliers are responsible for providing the compliance certificates to processors. To be compliant, the minimum testing for SCC is once per month and minimum testing for SPC is twice monthly.
3. Violation of the 400,000 cell/ml SCC limit is based on calculation of a rolling 3 month average value. If a farm's rolling 3 month SCC value exceeds the limit, then the AMS dairy program must be notified and measures taken to bring the farm into compliance. However, the farm can continue to ship milk during this period.
4. When a farm's 3 month rolling SCC exceeds the EU requirement for 3 consecutive months, then the milk supplier has 4 options in dealing with that farm:
 - a. Stop picking milk up from that farm
 - b. Segregate the products from that farm so that they are not included in any product lots that will be exported to the EU
 - c. Stop exporting milk to the EU
 - d. Ask for a deviation under special circumstances. In this instance, the milk supplier will pay a fee to AMS and institute corrective actions on the farm.
5. At the request of a farm, milk suppliers can ask for a "seasonal derogation" (deviation). The rules state that seasonal derogations will be granted to farms that can demonstrate that they are in compliance with the EU requirements for SCC for at least 9 months of the year and SCC violations occur only based on seasonal factors.
