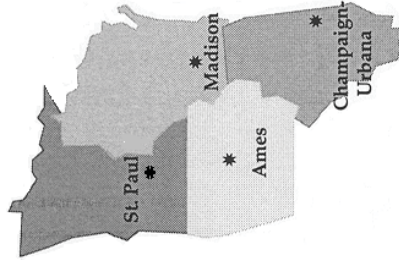

## Farmland Rent Resources

High land values and commodity prices are causing many landowners to reevaluate what they charge for land rent, and operators to reconsider how much they can afford to pay for land rent. There is no “one-size-fits-all” answer for “what is the going rate for land rent?”. Land rental prices depend on many factors including the land’s value, the renter’s payment ability and if the renter will follow good stewardship practices. The Dodge County UW-Extension office has resources for landowners and renters to help make land rental decisions. **CONVENIENT** - This test can be done on the same preserved milk samples collected on test day for routine DHI analysis. That is the biggest advantage of AgSource's Easy Mastitis Test.

**RELIABLE** - Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) technology is employed to detect strains of bacteria. PCR is a process that replicates DNA to quickly and positively identify pathogens, living or dead.

**FAST** - The Easy Mastitis Test has an advantage in speed. Once samples are received, results can be made available in two days or less, depending on laboratory volume.

**Easy Mastitis Test - Environmental Panel** is useful if you've ruled out contagious pathogens. Results from this test can be challenging to interpret. As the name implies, these pathogens are present in the environment. They may or may not be a cause of infection. PCR technology can detect the presence of the following pathogens within the sample, but cannot tell you with certainty if the pathogen came from within the udder or if it was simply an external contaminant. Though this test can be conducted on preserved DHI test-day samples, aseptic samples are recommended to minimize the presence of external contaminants.

2. *Staphylococcus spp.* (including all major coagulase-negative staphylococci)

**KEY POINTS** - This is not new technology, but it is evolving. PCR mastitis testing has been available in Europe, Canada and other areas of the U.S. for more than a year. AgSource has been carefully monitoring PCR's use and market acceptance to determine its potential as a management tool for our members. AgSource staff is working with veterinarians and University researchers to better understand and harness the power of this technology. It is important to note that Easy Mastitis Test results are not intended to be used as a diagnostic tool, but rather as a preventative measure. For best results, work with your veterinarian to devise an udder health plan. Work with your Field Technician to submit Easy Mastitis Test samples on test day.

Easy Mastitis Test does not replace traditional bacterial cultures. It is intended to be used as a screen. Aseptically collected bacterial cultures are recommended to verify positive Easy Mastitis Test pathogen results. Use this combination of test methods to most effectively pinpoint the source of udder health problems.

## Dairy 30x20 Initiative

Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP)

### Goal

Improve the long-term viability of Wisconsin's dairy industry through services to achieve an annual milk production of 30 billion pounds by 2020 to meet the growing demand of the marketplace.

### Need for a Dairy 30x20 Initiative

Wisconsin dairy farmers currently only produce approximately 90% of the milk volume needed by the state's dairy processors. Wisconsin's milk production grew less than 1% in 2011 to 26.1 billion pounds, which is not on pace to meet the future demands of the state's growing processing industry.

Dairy 30x20 will help secure a strong future for Wisconsin dairy farmers that will allow our state's dairy industry to maintain our diversity.

### Founding of the Dairy 30x20 Initiative

Wis. Act 32 provided an annual appropriation of \$200,000 of the former Dairy 2020 program funding to DATCP following the disbanding of the Wisconsin Department of Commerce. DATCP Secretary Ben Brancel convened dairy discussions with industry leaders from across the state to better understand the needs and demands of our farmers and processors. Suggestions from these discussions formed the priorities and services model of Dairy 30x20.

Organizations included in the discussion were the: Dairy Business Association, Cooperative Network, Professional Dairy Producers of Wisconsin, Wisconsin Farm Bureau Federation, Wisconsin Farmers Union, Wisconsin National Farmers Organization, Wisconsin Cheese Makers Association, Wisconsin Dairy Products Association, GrassWorks Inc, UW-Extension, Wisconsin Center for Dairy Research and Wisconsin Center for Dairy Profitability.

### Single Objective to Achieve Dairy 30x20

Assist Wisconsin dairy farmers, without regard to size or type, by focusing on long-term, sustained operation and increasing profitability and production.

# Wisconsin Dairy Industry Background Information

## Economic Impact

Dairy is the largest segment of Wisconsin agriculture. Of the \$59 billion economic impact of agriculture, \$26.5 billion is contributed to the dairy industry.

This means dairy means more to Wisconsin than citrus to Florida or potatoes to Idaho. Wisconsin dairy's \$26.5 billion compares to \$9.3 billion of Florida citrus or \$2.7 billion of Idaho potatoes.

Wisconsin is home to 1.27 million dairy cows. The average Wisconsin dairy cow generates more than \$20,000 a year in economic activity, which circulates throughout local communities.

## Dairy Industry's Impact on Jobs

The dairy industry accounts for nearly 40% of all Wisconsin agriculture jobs, employing more than 146,000 people in the state. Jobs created by dairy businesses bring long-term stability to local employment bases.

Dairy has many career opportunities in areas including production, animal science, biotechnology, equipment engineering and manufacturing, marketing and business.

## Producing Milk on our Farms

Wisconsin is home to over 11,000 licensed dairy herds, more than any other in the state. Even though farm numbers are decreasing across the nation, the increase of modern machinery, technology, better management practices, feeding programs and improved breeding have all combined to increase on-farm productivity.

In 2011, Wisconsin produced 26.1 billion pounds of milk, a record for Wisconsin. This was less than a 1% increase over 2010.

## Wisconsin is America's Dairyland

No other state offers the concentration of dairy resources and support network available in Wisconsin. Wisconsin's dairy infrastructure is highly-developed and specialized to support the industry's producers and processors.

Our farms are unique for their diversity. The average number of cows per Wisconsin dairy farm is 108 dairy cows. About 99% of Wisconsin farms are family-owned. Wisconsin ranks first in the number of organic dairy farms and has more dairy goats than any other state.

## Wisconsin Cheeses

In 2010, Wisconsin produced 2.6 billion pounds of cheese – more than any other state. Wisconsin cheese makers produce over 600 varieties, types and styles of cheese.

Wisconsin is home to more than 1,200 licensed cheese makers and is the only state with a Master Cheese Maker Program®.

Our cheeses are known for their quality. At the 2012 World Championship Cheese Contest, Wisconsin cheese won 30 gold medals out of 82 categories.

## Wisconsin Dairy Around the World

Dairy exports of milk, cheese, whey and butter continue to be valuable to the state. In 2011, Wisconsin exported a total value of \$231 million worth of dairy products, ranking fifth nationwide. This is an 8% increase over 2010.

Of these dairy product exports, \$106 million of cheese and curd were exported. Wisconsin ranks second in the nation for exports of cheese and curd. Our top export markets for cheese and curd are Mexico, Canada and Japan.

Exports of other products from the dairy industry, including livestock genetics, continue to be important. Wisconsin led the nation in the export of bovine semen in 2011.
